1. Where the nomenclature of a candidate's degree differs from the advertised subject, equivalence shall be determined by the University on the recommendation of the Screening Committee, subject to the applicable UGC norms. The decision of the University shall be final.

2. The minimum qualifications, pay scale and other conditions shall be governed by the UGC Regulations, 2018 and subsequent amendments, and by AICTE Regulations wherever applicable, together with the University Act, Statutes, Regulations and Rules.
3. A minimum of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale, wherever the grading system is followed) at the Master's level is essential. Relaxation of 5% at the Bachelor's and Master's levels shall be admissible to candidates belonging to SC/ST/ALC/PwBD categories only to the extent permitted under the applicable UGC/UT rules. Such relaxation shall be based on qualifying marks, without including any grace marks.
4. A relaxation of 5% (from 55% to 50%) shall be admissible to Ph.D. degree holders who obtained their Master's degree before 19 September 1991.
5. A candidate holding a Ph.D. degree from a foreign university shall submit an equivalence certificate issued by the Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi, wherever required. Candidates whose foreign Ph.D. was obtained under a Government of India scholarship programme may claim exemption only if supported by the applicable Government order.
6. Qualifications and experience shall be reckoned as on the closing date for submission of the online application.
7. The academic score under Annexure-I shall be used only for shortlisting. Final selection shall be based on interview performance in accordance with the applicable UGC Regulations.
8. Candidates must possess all essential qualifications on the closing date of application. Any qualification acquired after the closing date shall not be considered.

5. How to Apply

1. Eligible candidates shall submit the online application through the link available on the University website (<https://uol.ac.in>).
2. Candidates shall carefully read the advertisement and the instructions and satisfy themselves regarding eligibility before applying.
3. The email address and mobile number registered on the portal shall be used for future communication. The University shall not be responsible for non-receipt of communication due to an incorrect or inactive email address/mobile number furnished by the candidate.
4. Wherever applicable, candidates shall upload and enclose documentary proof relating to change of name/surname, such as a marriage certificate or Gazette notification.
5. A candidate already in service shall submit the application through proper channel. An advance copy may be submitted; however, the candidate must produce a No Objection Certificate and Vigilance Clearance Certificate from the employer at the time of interview, failing which the candidate shall not be permitted to appear in the interview.
6. 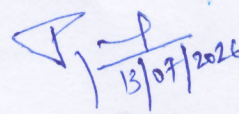
7. Terms and Conditions

1. Recruitment to the regular posts of Assistant Professor shall be made through an all-India advertisement, screening and selection by duly constituted committees in accordance with the UGC Regulations, 2018, AICTE Regulations wherever applicable, the applicable reservation rule/orders of the Union Territory of Ladakh, and the University Act, Statutes, Rules and Regulations, as amended from time to time.
2. Vertical reservation for ST/SC/ALC/EWS and horizontal reservation for PwBD shall be applied in accordance with the applicable Rules of UT Ladakh, the approved reservation rosters and orders issued from time to time.
3. Mere possession of the minimum qualifications shall not entitle a candidate to be called for interview.
4. The decision of the Vice-Chancellor/Competent Authority on eligibility, equivalence of qualifications, acceptance or rejection of applications, mode of selection and conduct of interview shall be final, subject to applicable law. No correspondence shall be entertained in this regard.
5. Candidates shall produce all original degree certificates, mark sheets, experience certificates as per UGC regulations-2018 and certificates relating to age, category and other claims at the time of interview. Failure to produce original documents shall result in cancellation of candidature.
6. The University may restrict the number of candidates to be called for interview by prescribing criteria higher than the minimum qualifications, on the recommendation of the duly constituted Screening Committee. Interview call letters shall be sent only by email to shortlisted candidates.
7. The selection procedure shall be governed by the UGC Regulations on Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and Other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education, 2018, and subsequent amendments/clarifications.
8. Relaxation in marks and other concessions for reserved categories shall be allowed only as provided under the applicable UGC/UT rules and upon submission of a valid certificate issued by the competent authority.
9. No TA/DA shall be paid for attending the interview.
10. Any corrigendum, amendment, schedule or update relating to the recruitment process shall be published only on the University website. Candidates are advised to visit the website regularly.
11. Candidates claiming ST/SC/ALC/EWS/PwBD status shall submit the prescribed certificate in the format notified by the competent government authority. All supporting documents shall be self-attested. If any certificate or claim is found false or invalid, the candidature/appointment shall be cancelled and further action may be taken under law.
12. The closing date for submission of the online application shall be the date for determining eligibility in all respects.

13. Candidates are responsible for assessing their eligibility and furnishing complete and correct information. Suppression of facts, production of false documents or furnishing misleading information shall result in cancellation of candidature or termination of appointment, as the case may be, without prejudice to legal action.
14. The University may verify the antecedents and documents of a candidate at any stage of the recruitment process or during service. Appointment shall be liable to cancellation if any information or document is found false, fabricated or suppressed.
15. Appointment shall be subject to satisfactory police verification of character and antecedents.
16. The University reserves the right to revise, reschedule, suspend, cancel or withdraw the recruitment process, wholly or partly, without assigning any reason, subject to applicable law.
17. If an inadvertent error is detected at any stage, including after issue of an appointment letter, the University may correct, modify, withdraw or cancel the relevant communication/selection, in accordance with law.
18. The number of vacancies may be increased, decreased or withdrawn depending upon administrative requirements.
19. Interim enquiries regarding the recruitment process shall not be entertained.
20. Canvassing in any form shall disqualify the candidate.
21. The decision of the Screening Committee regarding screening and shortlisting shall be final, subject to review by the Competent Authority and applicable law.
22. Pay, allowances, service conditions and age of superannuation shall be governed by the applicable UGC norms and University rules/UT Ladakh Rules, as amended from time to time. A selected candidate shall execute the prescribed service agreement at the time of joining.
23. A person appointed by direct recruitment shall be on probation for one year in the first instance, or for such period as may be prescribed under the University Statutes/Rules. The appointing authority may extend the period of probation in accordance with the applicable rules.
24. A selected candidate must be medically fit and shall produce a certificate of medical fitness from the prescribed Medical Board/competent medical authority.

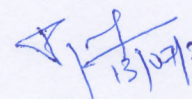
